MAINTENANCE CORNER

With fall upon us, Maintenance would like to remind everyone to check your furnace filters. If they need to be changed out, you can get a new filter at the Leasing Office for free. If Maintenance has not inspected your furnace and water heater this year, we ask that you call and schedule a time for them to come out and do that. They will replace your filter for you and check your exterior exhaust vents. Make sure to dust or vacuum the furnace intake vent, which is the large vent located in the ceiling or on top of the wall of the first or second floor (this vent does not require a filter). Also, make sure furniture and items are not covering or too close to the small register vents on the floors and ceilings. It's a good idea to vacuum those out as well once or twice a year.
